DIRECTOR'S NOTES

Can people be redeemed in real life or is that just something that happens in fiction? Do we need to be visited by apparitions to understand the need to make reparations?

For some real people, a dramatic life event or drastic loss or near-miss prompts introspection and a vow to "do better" or to "carpe diem" but unlike fictional characters, we are fallible creatures who may not live up to our own redemptive resolutions on a daily basis.

Most of my favorite fictional characters have some sort of redemptive arc to their stories, where they come to see they are a vital part of the whole and their connectedness with and compassion for other people are the only way to find love and joy: George Bailey, Elizabeth Bennet and Mr. Darcy, Sydney Carton, Mary Lennox, Jean Valjean, and even the Grinch, who was probably my first brush with a character who didn't like Christmas.

I don't recall my first encounter with *A Christmas Carol*, whether it was a cartoon or grainy black and white movie. I do have a well-loved, beautifully illustrated copy of the book given to me by my parents so I know it was a holiday presence in our house. I've seen many versions and reworked takes on Dickens' classic and I still find myself pulling the original book off the shelf to reread on a chilly night.

Charles Dickens wrote A Christmas Carol as a response to the outrage of children living in abject poverty and society's indifference to their plight. Dickens himself was not a perfect practitioner of personal goodness but his writing has served as a reminder to think of "Christmas time, when it has come round as good time; a kind, forgiving, charitable, pleasant time; the only time...in the long calendar of the year, when men and women seem by one consent to open their shut-up hearts freely, and to think of people as if they really were fellow-passengers to the grave."

Of course, indifference and downright cruelty still haunt the world. With this production we aim to put forth the lessons and the hope of the original tale. Putting this show on has been a loving and joyful experience. Our Company of actors and creative artists range in age from 6 to 68 and we have all grown from each other's giving spirits.

Thank you for starting your holiday season with us. From all of our Christmas Carol Company, may love and joy come to you! God bless us, every one!

A Note from T&C's President

Welcome to the Town and Country Players' 2022 Season. This represents a milestone year in our history, as this is our 75th season of bringing quality community theater to the Bucks County Area.

Town and Country Players got its start in 1948, with a production of *The Late George Apley*, performed at the Doylestown Borough School. T&C moved to our current location, "The Barn," in 1953, renting the barn until we purchased it in 1962. Throughout the years, we have made many improvements to our space, including air conditioning, catwalks, raked seating, sound and lighting improvements, and - perhaps most importantly - our addition in 2014 which tripled the number of restrooms and added rehearsal space.

That said, T&C is more than just the name and the barn that we perform in. If one looks at our database of past productions, one will find a list of nearly 4000 individuals who have been involved in our productions over the years, from actors, musicians, directors, and producers, to designers, technicians, carpenters, stage crew, and stage managers. This doesn't include those members who have supported us in other areas, including the myriad of business/operational areas required to continuously bring productions to the stage.

Of course, all the effort required to bring a production to the stage wouldn't count for much without the support of our community. From the 400 patrons who came to see *The Late George Apley* in 1948 to the 150 who can fill the house for each performance our intimate theater today, without our patrons, all those hours and late nights spent rehearsing, designing, building would be for naught.

I also want to thank all those who have donated to T&C over the years. Your generosity has enabled us to keep the lights on, improve our infrastructure, and weather hard times (like the last couple of years).

When we started to plan our 75th season, we decided to focus on large cast, generally happy/uplifting shows after two seasons impacted by COVID. We also wanted to celebrate our 75th season by selecting shows with either a tie to either T&C or to the Bucks County area. While Charles Dickens' classic certainly has a dreary start, *A Christmas Carol* shifts into an enchanting tale before the tale concludes. While T&C has never before produced *A Christmas Carol*, it does have a local connection, as a production at Byers' Choice has frequently drawn Dickens' kin to attend.
